Notes from the meeting of the Friends of Hartley Park held on 08/11/2004
7pm at the Rising Sun, Egguckland Road.

Mr. Clifton opened the meeting, and called on Mr. Delamare to give the
secretary's report, the main points were:

1. Donations of £7 had been received and were passed to the treasurer (Mr. Clifton).
2. Various items relating to the history of the park were passed to Mrs. Shaddick.
3. Updated plans have been received from the council in October and a copy was on
the website, copies are available from Reads DIY Stores, 134 Egguckland Road.
4. Mr. Delamare outlined the various groups that may be able to help the friends
improve the park, either with funding or advice, these were: Living spaces, Plymouth
tree partnership, Green Space, Sport England, Cabe Space, Heritage Lottery Fund,
Public parks initiative scheme.

Mr. Fry said that if a list of these bodies were supplied to him, the council
would be able to supply advice on how to get funding, and which ones would be more
suitable, Mr. Delamare said he would supply a list.

A discussion about the current state of the park commenced, which included
the fact that a tennis court had received new fencing all round, and two new sets of
swings were being installed. Mr. Snell said he would contact Nick Jones about the
following subjects: The urgent demolition of the current shelter, the reinstatement of
the sign board, and to arrange a meeting with the tree officer Dave Wilson, to get the
condition of the trees surveyed and work started as soon as possible.

**Some problems were identified with the updated plans, and a meeting to
discuss these was arranged for 22/11/2004 at 24 Hartley Park Gardens 7pm.
anyone who would like to discuss the plans should attend.**

Volunteers for groups to progress funding applications were taken, and enough
volunteers for four groups were found.

Dean Price from the Plymouth Tree Partnership said he would Liaise with
Mrs. Stephens and Mrs. Hope and enroll Hartley park as a member.

Mr. Delamare said he would apply to Green Space to enroll Hartley Park as
members.

The meeting closed at 8.30 pm.
